I get in too many accidents.

We have bought Medical Tracker which enables us to alert parents via email if an accident happens. This also helps to identify where accident hotspots are.

By fixing and removing broken playground equipment, more space has become available on the yards.

I don't like times tables.

We are having regular inter-year group and classes TTRS Battles for Years 3-6 – results are published on the school website.

Staff have had training to make time tables more interactive and fun.

Times tables are re-visited daily in Years 2-6.

It can get too noisy.

We are regularly modelling and explicitly teaching
what 'good' behaviour looks and sounds like.

Children are asked to walk quietly around the
school and use their inside voices.

Children who are distracting others from learning
are reminded of our expectations: kind,
responsible and respectful.

I worry that I might
have arguments.

We work hard to support children to build strong
relationships at school. Children are taught that it is
ok to fall out with friends and have a different opinion.

When things go wrong, staff are trained to support
children to have restorative conversations, take
ownership for their behaviour and put things right.

At playtime, sometimes the grown-ups have to go in and I can't find them

The children are reminded that there is always a member of staff from their year group out every playtime.

We have invested in walkie-talkies for every year group.

We have bought high-vis jackets for all Midday Supervisors so that children can identify adults quickly.

I have to wake up too early! I'd like to start later!

Unfortunately, we can't start later. The Government tells us that children have to be at school for 32.5 hours each week – if we start later, we will have to finish later!
