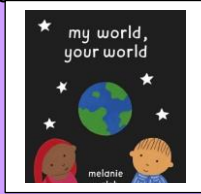
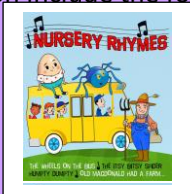
Nursery



Welcome back to all our children and families. We hope that you have had a wonderful summer break. We look forward getting to know our new children and families joining the Nursery this term and to continuing our work in partnership with you to support your child's learning.

Topics

Our theme for the first half of the Autumn term is 'Marvellous me'. We will be sharing, talking about and reading stories around what we like to do, our special interests and making friends. We are also focusing on singing lots of Nursery Rhymes together so please sing these at home too! We would like to walk to Bulwell library this half term and would welcome any parent helpers. Nursery Timings

Nursery doors are open at 8.30am- 8.45am. All parents may enter from the main entrance gate. It is important that all children arrive on time every day, so they do not miss out on any potential teaching and learning. Morning Nursery collection is between 11.20am - 11.30am. Afternoon Nursery children enter via the side gate adjacent to the main gate at 12.30pm - 12.45pm and collection is at 3.30pm from the main Nursery doors on the school site. Thank you for your support and cooperation and for arriving promptly to drop off and collect your child each day. Come and join us on a Friday for Reading Morning/Afternoon at the start of the session and borrow a book from our Reading Library

Keeping safe at school

As the weather is getting cooler, please can all children come to Nursery with a warm coat and hat as we go outside all year round (please make sure everything is clearly labelled with names on). We also ask for all children to bring a water bottle every day. We are a healthy school so only water and no juices or squash. Thank you.

Supporting your child at home

Please support your child's development and independence by:

- ✓ encouraging them to be as independent as possible at home, to get dressed by themselves and attempt to put on their own coats. Help them to begin to fasten these eg allowing them to pull the zip up.
- ✓ Have fun sharing lots of stories and singing lots of songs together.
- ✓ Talking about what we see and hear all around us as they walk or travel to and from school or are out and about in Bulwell or further afield.
- ✓ Talking about and encouraging healthy eating.

Number Time
