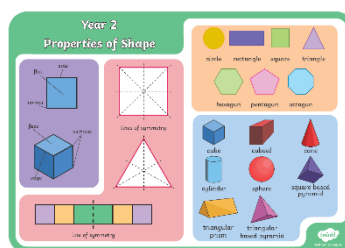
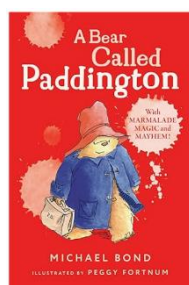
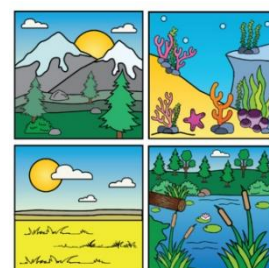
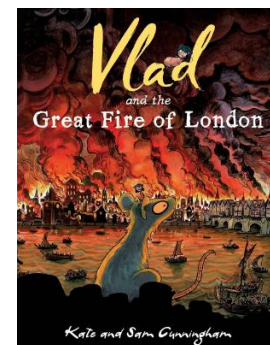


SPRING TERM NEWSLETTER YEAR 2

History	How was school different in the past? & How did we learn to fly?
Geography	Why is our world wonderful?
RSHE	Feeling safe, the internet & my health.
ICT	Spreadsheets, questioning & coding.
Music	Grandma rap.
RE	How do we know some people feel a special connection to a god? & What is a prophet?
Art	Painting and drawing – Vincent van Gogh (Starry Night).
D&T	Mechanisms – wheels and axels (fire engines) & food - salads.



We ask that you listen to your child read their school reading book as much as possible and record it in their reading diary. Any other reading your child does at home can be recorded too! We are going to be quizzing the children each week on their times table knowledge, so please practice these with your child at home. We focus mostly on the 10- and 5- times tables in the Spring term. English and Phonics homework is set on Class Dojo and Maths homework is set on Mathletics (every Friday). Paper copies available on request.
