I worry about tripping over on the playground.

Mr Vernon and Mr Barrett regularly check all of the equipment and areas on each of the playgrounds to make sure that it is safe for you to use.

There's too many accidents at lunchtime on the playground.

The Midday Supervisors are there to make sure that everyone feels safe and have a good time at lunchtime.

The playgrounds where the older children play are 'zoned.' This ensures that there are areas available for children to run, play games, areas to sit and chat to your friends and areas that you can carry out quiet craft activities.

I would like some more work on playing games equally.

The Midday Supervisors meet every week with Mrs Tomkinson. In that meeting, Mr Francis shares an idea of a playground game that Midday Supervisors can be play with a group of children to practise social skills.

There's a lot of children in the corridor at the same time in Year 5 and 6 – sometimes I get pushed when we have to hang our coats up before going into class.

The teachers have been spoken to and they are now asking children to take their coats into class and hang them on the back of the chairs – if they are going into a different class away from their coat pegs.

Some of the positive things you said about Cantrell Primary School:

Children are treated the same.

I feel confident that bullying is dealt with.

Adults listen to me when I am sad. They help me to feel happy.

Teachers help us to know how to keep safe on the internet.

Children are kind. They help you when you are upset to tell an adult.

There are lots of ways you can tell an adult that you are upset: tell an adult, tell a friend who can help you, write in your journal, write a note and put it in the worry box.

Teachers help us when we have fallen out with our friends and to put it right.

My teacher does a check-in everyday and we can write in our journal to let them know if we want to talk about anything.
