**A REMINDER OF TEMPORARY SCHOOL OPENING TIMES & ENTRANCES.** Please note the timings are very tight! **SCHOOL MEALS PRICE INCREASE.** From **1<sup>st</sup> September** the price of a school meal has increased to **£2.25** per day/**£11.25** per week. We have a varied, nutritionally balanced menu which meets the government food standards and gives value for money.
