Please ensure children come to school in warm outdoor clothing, plus waterproof clothing/wellies in a separate bag. CORONAVIRUS UPDATE. We are writing to again ask you to work with us over the half term break to continue the fight against the virus. If your child or any of your children develop coronavirus symptoms within 2 days of their last day at school and then subsequently test positive for coronavirus, or if they don't have symptoms and have a coronavirus test within 2 days of their last day at school, then you should contact us via email to headteacher@cantrell.nottingham.sch.uk. For example, pupils who attend school on the last day of term on Friday 28th May, this would mean notifying us of pupil symptoms developing on Saturday 29th, Sunday 30th, and Monday 31st May. To get a test use the NHS COVID-19 app, via www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test or by calling NHS on **119**. Many test results are now being received 24 hours after the test. We will make sure staff from school will be available from Saturday 29th May to Tuesday 1st June from 10am to 11am and 1pm to 2pm to receive your messages by email at headteacher@cantrell.nottingham.sch.uk. We will then, as a school, take advice from Public Health England in terms of notifying other children, families, school staff or bubbles to self-isolate.

MAY HALF TERM FREE SCHOOL MEAL VOUCHERS. The government have extended Covid support for vulnerable families. A £15 supermarket food voucher has again been provided to every eligible child in Nottingham. A link was sent via email yesterday, please check inbox and spam/junk for an email from Edenred.

MISSING SCOOTER. A child's scooter with 'I Blaze' written on it in orange letters has gone missing from the front of school. Parents please check if your child has the correct scooter and if not, please return it to school.
