Main gate

- Year 4 arrive 8:30 – 8:45am Leave 3:00 – 3:10pm – **please queue on opposite side of gate, do not gather in a group.**
- Year 3 arrive 8:50 – 9:00am Leave 3:10 – 3:20pm
- Year 1 arrive 9:00 – 9:10am Leave 3:20 – 3:30pm

- RA/RB arrive 8:45am Leave 3:00pm
- Nursery 30 hours children arrive 9:00am Leave 3:00pm
- Morning nursery arrive 9:00am Leave 11:00am
